







## Proper Chain Routing Through Lift Arm

## Issue:

This bulletin will serve as notice on an update to both the Sno-Pro<sup>™</sup> 3000 Series & Home Pro Series Assembly Instructions. Below are two diagrams pulled directly from the assembly manual showing proper routing of the lift chain through the lift arm. As shown in the diagrams the chain should be properly routed up through the bottom of the lift arm with remaining chain slack resting towards the front of the lift arm. Improper routing may cause lift arm wear or damage. Please update any appropriate personnel on this Service Bulletin.
